## MOU SIGNING AND INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC LECTURE: "THE ISLAMIC FINANCIAL SERVICES" BY IDB-IRTI



Universitas Hasanuddin and Islamic Development Bank – Islamic Research & Training Institute (IDB-IRTI) agreed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding on October, 11th 2018 in Makassar. The event was started with the MoU signing between Unhas and IDB-IRTI in regards to Islamic finance and economics program study development. Furthermore, based on the MoU, UNHAS will propose a new study program focusing on digital Islamic economics & finance & supported by IDB-IRTI. UNHAS Rector expressed sincere appreciation for IDB-IRTI assistance and willingness to support UNHAS. The event was followed with a public lecture delivered by the Director of IDB-IRTI, Prof. Dr. Humayon Dar. He explained in his lecture that Islamic Finance Industry grew rapidly in accordance to the development of Global Finance. He added that the total assets of Islamic Bank accounts for 1.6 trillion USD currently.

Indonesia itself accounts for 1.8% from the total assets of Islamic Banks and Finance globally, and Islamic Banking and Finance Industry has a potential to grow to 6.5 trillion USD by 2020. Prof. Humayon Dar stated that Indonesia will play a significant role in the future in this regard because currently Indonesia has already positioned number 6th in Global Islamic Finance index rank.

The public lecture organized by Department of Communication, Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, Universitas Hasanuddin in collaboration with Deakin University assembled two topics about film and culture. Senior lecturer Simon Wilmot gave a lecture entitled “Making Sense of The World through Stories” while Senior lecturers Glenn Auld & Lena Djabiba gave a lecture about Language and Cultural Similarities between Makassar and Maningrida.

Giving a lecture in front of Communication students from Universitas Hasanuddin and Universitas Muslim Indonesia, those three lecturers attractively built students’ awareness on reinforcing the existing Indonesia-Australia relationship to deal with global challenges.

At the end of the public lecture, Richard Mathews stated that Indonesia-Australia had together managed away so many challenges in Indonesia’s colonization era that proved—together we are strong.

## PUBLIC LECTURE "HYDROLOGY REMOTE SENSING & DISASTER MANAGEMENT"



On Friday, November 2nd, 2018, Directorate of Partnership & International Office of Universitas Hasanuddin hosted a public lecture in Hydrology remote sensing and disaster management, delivered by Prof. Yuei An Liou from National Central University, Taiwan. The public lecture was officially opened by the Vice Rector for Research, Innovation and Partnership; Prof. dr. Muh. Nasrum Massi, Ph. D., and moderated by Dr. Ilham Alimuddin, MGIS. from Geological Engineering Department.

Lecturers and students from Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Forestry, & Faculty of Agriculture attended this important event. At the beginning of his lecture, Prof. Liou, who has 2 Master Degrees & 2 PhDs in the field of atmospheric remote sensing & weather at The University of Michigan USA, described the definition of disaster and how it can be mapped using remote sensing technology. He further explained his expertise in proposing a new index in processing satellite imagery in the form of NDLI (Normalized Difference on Latent Heat) Index, using a new formula regarding on the latent heat index of satellite image recording.

# VISIT BY REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND

On 12 October 2018, Mr. Chai Isarabhakdi and Ms. Ratu Sovi Arinta from the University of Queensland, Australia visited Universitas Hasanuddin, and had meeting with UNHAS officials to explore more possible collaboration in the future.

# UNHAS AT INDONESIAN UNIVERSITY FAIR 2018, MANILA



On Sunday, 21 of October 2018, Universitas Hasanuddin participated in Indonesian University Fair 2018, which took place at Activity Center Glorietta, Makati, Metro Manila, Philippines. More than 10 Indonesian Universities participated in this event.

The expo was hosted by the Embassy of The Republic of Indonesia in Manila, specifically organized by The Education and cultural attache, Dr. LiliNurlaili, M.Ed.

In her welcome remarks, she explained that this was the first University fair in Philippines, she initiated the event due to the fact that there were limited number of collaborations between Indonesian's & Philippines's Universities. Therefore, she considered this Fair an important event to facilitate the information exchange among universities in the two countries.

Many visitors from Universities in Philippine were interested to UNHAS especially for the Maritime studies and Psychology study program. Several visitors were also interested in the products produced by UNHAS teaching industry. In the presentation session, the Head of International Office of Unhas; Karmila Mokoginta, M.Arts, delivered a presentation about UNHAS.



## KOREAN AMBASSADOR VISITED UNHAS

On Monday, 29 October 2018, the Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to Indonesia, H.E. Chang-beom Kim visited Universitas Hasanuddin (UNHAS). The ambassador was accepted by UNHAS rector, Professor. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu at the rector's office, and they discussed various topics regarding the relationship between Indonesia and South Korea, especially in the field of education. As part of this visit, there was an announcement of the Grant of Resources for Korean Studies from the Korea Foundation and the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in Indonesia to UNHAS. The grant includes a total of 118 books and DVDs on Korea and Korean language. After that, the ambassador gave a public lecture to about 130 lecturers and students from UNHAS and other institutions; and visited Korean Corner at the Central Library of UNHAS.

## UNHAS & NTU COLLABORATE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ABOUT TECTONIC AND MAGMATIC IN SULAWESI ISLAND

The research team of tectonics and magmatic on Sulawesi island which is a collaboration between the Disaster Research Center in collaboration with National Taiwan University collected data in several active volcanoes in the northern part of Sulawesi, including Soputan Mountain and Lokon Mountain. The team was led by the Head of Research and Development Center for Disaster Studies Unhas, Dr. Eng. Ir. Adi Maulana, ST. M.Phil and the Head of the Taiwan National Research Institute for Earth Sciences, Prof. Sun-Lin Chung. Data collection, which was also joined by several researchers and students from Gorontalo State University, took place from 7th to 12th October 2018. The research team conducted a survey from Gorontalo to Manado to observe volcanic activity in the northern part of Sulawesi. It is because, after the latest earthquake in Palu, Mount Soputan in North Sulawesi was active and started to release volcanic dust. It is expected that the latest rock petrology & geochemical data can provide an illustration of the eruption properties whether it is rather explosive (high explosive power) or tend to be effusive (low explosive power). This research is expected to provide information in an effort to reduce the risk of the disaster, especially volcanic eruptions that are closely related to the tectonic activities of Sulawesi island and in several other parts of Indonesia.

## HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY AND THE FUTURE OF INDONESIAN FOREIGN POLICY



On 20 Oct 2018, the International Relations Department attended the annual Conference on Indonesian Foreign Policy, hosted by the Foreign Policy Community of Indonesia (FPCI). The event is the largest conference on Indonesian Foreign Policy, attended by academics, diplomats, and practitioners related to the advancement of Indonesia's position in global affairs. Taking place in Jakarta, Indonesia, thousands of participants gathered to comprehensively evaluate and analyze the past and future direction of Indonesia's foreign policy.

Unhas was entrusted to lead one of its most vital sessions, under the theme of 'Evaluating President Jokowi's Foreign Policy and What to Expect in the Next 12 Months.' M. Ashry Sallatu, the Secretary of the International Relations Department of Hasanuddin University was given the opportunity to moderate the session, which included key figures of the Indonesian Foreign Policy. The keynote speeches focused on a wide topic related to the Indonesian foreign policy. Participants were astonished with the analysis made on Jokowi's recent developments in foreign policy, the development and direction of Indonesia's Global Maritime Fulcrum, and what the past policies have told us in predicting the future 12 months of the foreign policy orientation.

It was an honor for Unhas to take active participation in the prestigious event.

The International Relations Department has maintained close relations with the Foreign Policy Community of Indonesia (FPCI). Hosting seminars, conferences, & student-based events, it the hope of the department to continue its solid partnership with FPCI.
