INTERNATIONAL CULTURAL PROGRAM 2019 OPENED, INVOLVING PARTICIPANTS FROM 20 COUNTRIES



Universitas Hasanuddin through the International Office officially opened an annual event “International Cultural Program (ICP) 2019”. This year event, ICP 2019 took a theme “Maritime Culture In Indonesia: Marine Resilience and Historical Perspective”. The opening ceremony was held on Monday (12/08) at 10.00 WITA in LPMPP HALL B, Unhas Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar. Thirty five participants from 20 countries participates in ICP 2019.

The Head of International Office of Unhas, Karmila Mokoginta, explains that ICP 2019 with a theme related to maritime affairs in South Sulawesi will focus on visiting locations in Bulukumba Regency.

The visit in Bulukumba Regency will show participants about South Sulawesi’s accomplished

seafarers, including the beach, fishing community, and the Phinisi shipbuilding process.

“After the opening ceremony of ICP 2019, the participants will be guided for a campus tour. Firstly, we will take them to the library center to show Unhas facilities and services of some language corners from different countries. Then, we plan to visit the Teaching Industry and Unhas Campus Gowa” said Karmila.

On this occasion, Karmila Mokoginta hoped this event can be a form of promotion for Unhas in national and international level. Besides that, she expected this event will be an opportunity for Unhas students to build a network with the foreigner students.

EXPERT FROM USA PRESENTS RESEARCH ABOUT BANGGAI FISHERMEN AT THE FACULTY OF MARINE SCIENCE & FISHERIES UNHAS

The Faculty of Marine Sciences and Fisheries of UNHAS held a public lecture that discussed human & marine resources. The public lecture presented Shannon Switzer Swanson BSC BA MEM from the United States. This activity took place in the FIKP Unhas Senate Room, Makassar, Tuesday (8/13/2019). This public lecture took the main theme "Time is Money: Motivators of Destructive Fishing Practices and Management Responses in Bojan Kepulauan, Banggai Laut District of Indonesia".

Shannon as the speaker focused his explanation on the research conducted to the fishing community in Banggai Regency, Central Sulawesi. The results of preliminary research conducted showed that the fishing community, especially ornamental fish fishermen in the Banggai district mostly used potassium to catch ornamental fish. Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa PhD as the Dean of the Graduate Program responded that the results of research conducted by the speaker could be one of the references for teaching materials in the future.

THE INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC CONSORTIUM FOR SUSTAINABLE CITIES 2019



Universitas Hasanuddin became the host of the '10th International Academic Consortium for Sustainable Cities (IACSC) 2019.' Under the theme of "Creating Resilient Cities with Diverse Urban Resources," this International Conference was successfully held on 27 August 2019, in the IPTEK Building of Universitas Hasanuddin, Makassar.

The International Academic Consortium consists of 7 universities, which include Yokohoma City University (Japan), University of Nigata Prefecture (Japan), University Sains Malaysia (Malaysia), Thammasat University (Thailand), Vietnam National University Ussh (Vietnam), University of the Philippines (Philippines), and Universitas Hasanuddin (Indonesia). The seven universities collaborated in establishing and advancing sustainable cities that are environmentally friendly.

For the 10th IACSC, the keynote speakers focused on several specific aspects that are critical in establishing sustainable cities. From Universitas Hasanuddin, Prof. Dr. Eng. Dadang Ahmad Suriamihardja talked on the theme of "The Beauty Interconnected Patterns," and Prof. Hidefumi Imura from Yokohama Univ, focused his speech on "Land Reclamation and Coastal Urban Development - Lessons From Japan."

Besides the speakers mentioned, several other invited speakers include Prof. Ngai Weng Chan (Professor in the field of Environmental Management, Universitas Sains Malaysia) with the title "Environmental Impact and Its Implication of Land Reclamation: Case of Penang and Malaysia," Professor Badaruddin Mohamed (Professor in the field tourism) discussing "Land Reclamation Issue from urban Planning and Tourism Viewpoint," as well as Ansariadi, Ph.D. (Unhas), that talked on the issue of "Revitalizing Informal Settlements and Their Environment."

In showing their support, a number of high officials of Universitas Hasanuddin attended the event. Vice Dean on Academic Affairs, Faculty of Engineering, Prof. Ir. Baharuddin, ST., M.Arch. Ph.D. opened the event and stated how the event was challenged to establish new discourses in establishing sustainable cities. Dr. Muh. Iqbal Djawas, Director of Partnership UNHAS, stated how the event attracted 100 participants that consisted of 45 students from 7 different universities.

THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CIVIL AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING (ICCEE) 2019



The Department of Civil Engineering & the Department of Environmental Engineering of UHAS, collaborated in establishing “The 3rd International Conference on Civil & Environmental Engineering (ICCEE) 2019.” The conference adopted the theme of “Toward Sustainable Green Infrastructure Development in Industrial Revolution 4.0 Era,” taking place at the Patra Hotel (Bali), on August 29th-30th, 2019.

ICCEE 2019 invited participants to present papers on 9 main topics, which include geotechnical & rock mechanics, maritime and coastal infrastructure, project management & construction, environmental engineering, structure & material, transportation & logistics, smart and green infrastructure, water & river engineering, & city planning. 164 papers were presented by 200 participants ranging from Japan, Indonesia, France, South Korea, Malaysia, Sudan, Australia, & Indonesia. Besides developing an academic discourse on the stated topics, the conference was majorly aimed at establishing relations & collaborations among the institutions involved.

In advancing academic discourses green infrastructure development in the industrial revolution 4.0 era, ICCEE 2019 invited several keynote speakers--Mrs. Dewi Chomistriana (Secretary to the DirGen of Construction of the Ministry of Public Works & Public Housing), Prof. Alexander Babanin (Ocean Engineering, the University of Melbourne). Besides the keynotes speakers, participants attained the honor of listening to 6 invited speakers--Prof. Kenichi Tsukahara (Kyushu University), Prof. Sun-Kyun Kim (Seoul National University), Prof. Yoshihiro Narito (Hokkaido University), Assoc. Prof. Susilawati (Monash University), Dr. William Sabandar (President Director of PT. MRT), & Dr. Farid Padang (President-Director of PT. Pelindo).

Prof. Dwia A. Pulubuhu, Rector of UNHAS, expressed her enthusiasm and support for the conduct of the ICCEE 2019. In her speech, she states that there is a growing demand for green infrastructure, & UNHAS is one of the universities in Indonesia that is currently rapidly developing efforts in establishing green spaces for the locals to enjoy. She further stated how the support of government stakeholders such as the Ministry of Public Works and Housing is among the stakeholders that helped assist this process.

A DEEPER INSIGHT ON REMOTE SENSING APPLICATION & GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS



Australian expert, Prof. Armando Apan, gave a public lecture with the theme “Application of Remote Sensing and GIS in Environmental Management and Agriculture,” taking place on August 9, 2019, at the Universitas Hasanuddin Graduate School. The public lecture was in collaboration of the Graduate School of Regional Planning and Development Study Program and the Study Program of Agriculture.

The application of Remote Sensing and GIS is viewed as essential to advance knowledge of the public lecture participants. The multidisciplinary application of its represents its importance, as it can be utilized in the fields of environment, agriculture, as well as stakeholders, including students and researchers. Responding to the enthusiasm of the public lecture participants, Prof. Armando Apan

stated, “I am highly enthusiastic in bringing a public lecture here, as the participants have expressed deep enthusiasm to the topic of remote sensing and GIS. I hope to be back here to bring another public lecture.” Besides the application of Remote Sensing and GIS, the public lecture focused on the principles of GIS application, its application in the management of the environment, as well as the application in the field of agriculture.

The public lecture attracted 60 participants, ranging from students, researchers, and academic staff, majorly from the study programs of agriculture and regional planning and development.

DENTAL HEALTH EXPERT FROM THE UNITED STATES INVITED TO A GUEST LECTURE AT HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY



Faculty of Dentistry of Universitas Hasanuddin conducted a guest lecture which is part of the collaboration between the science and technology DIASPORA & Department of Research, Technology and Higher Education, as well as the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC). The activity that discusses "The current update of the dentistry field in the United States of America" took place at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Hasanuddin.

The guest lecture which took place on August 20, 2019, presented Dr. Cartino Sukotjo, DDS, Ph.D., MMSc, who is an Associate Professor of Dental Medicine at the University of Illinois, Chicago, United States. The Dean of Faculty of Dentistry of Universitas Hasanuddin, drg. Muhammad Ruslin M. Kes, Ph.D., Sp.BM (K) explained that the purpose of this guest lecture was also to establish collaborative

research in dentistry.

This guest lecture was divided into two sessions. The first session discussed the results of Dr. Cartino Sukotjo's research which is related to the process of modifying the implant in the denture installing process, the development of dentistry technology at UCI, and the way to establish collaboration with other campuses.

The second session discusses the process of writing a good manuscript to make it easier to be indexed in Scopus. This activity was attended by 80 participants comprises of lecturers and students of the Faculty of Dentistry of Universitas Hasanuddin such as periodonsia and prosthodontics specialists.

UNHAS CONDUCTED AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON NUTRITION AND PUBLIC HEALTH (ICNPH)



The Faculty of Public Health of the University of Hasanuddinn held the 1st International Conference on Nutrition and Public Health (ICNPH). This first conference took the theme “Accelerating Stunting Reduction through the First 1000 days of Life Intervention in Response to Environmental Challenges. This year’s theme is one of the issues that Unhas has concerned about which is related to stunting. ICNPH takes place at the Claro Hotel Ballroom Makassar, on Friday, August 2, 2019.

This conference invited nutrition and health experts who have competencies in their fields, including Professor Soekiman, SKM, MOS-ID., Ph.D. (known as nutrition experts), Professor Dr. Abdul Razak Thaha M.Sc. Sp.GK (Nutrition Specialist at Unhas), and Ir. Herwin Yatim, MM (Regent of Bantaeng). The Vice-Rector for Research, Innovation, and Partnership of Universitas Hasanuddinn in his

remarks appreciated the conference and he hoped that this conference could provide a lot of new information and knowledge related to stunting. The head of the conference committee, Rahayu Indriasari, Ph.D. explained that the number of stunting in Indonesia based on existing data has increased from year to year. Stunting which is considered normal for Asian people, especially in Indonesia, is a complex issue. Stunting is not just about body size but it affects the intelligence of children and is prone to degenerative diseases.

As a tertiary institution, there is a level of responsibility of Universitas Hasanuddinn to assist the government in reducing stunting issues. Therefore, by conducting this ICNPH, not only it raised the awareness of the stunting but also provide the prevention and solution related to stunting.

FACULTY OF FORESTRY HELD A CONFERENCE ON WALLACEA



Faculty of Forestry UNHAS in collaboration with Burung Indonesia held “International Conference on Wildlife & Utilization in Wallacea Region”. The conference took place at the Dalton Hotel, Makassar, Thursday (22/08) under a theme “Harmonizing Human - Wildlife Relationship for Sustainable Environmental Management in the Wallacea Region”. As known as the region having the most endemic suppliers, this conferences primarily aimed to obtain a huge understanding to the trade in wild plants & animals conducted in Wallacea Region, to find out if there are flora or fauna that are in crisis or endangered. Thus, the effort of prevention & countermeasures can be considerably taken.

Those aims were mostly gained from some presentations carried by the participants who discussed 5 main topics namely Wildlife

Hunting & Trade in the Wallacea Region, Ethno Biological Studies in the Wallacea Region, Policy & Law Enforcement on Wildlife (Plants and Animals), Utilization Occured in the Wallacea Region, Captive Breeding & Domestication of Wild Plants & Animals in the Wallacea Region, General Topic: Forests & Conservation of the Wallacea Region.

The conference was attended by more than 300 participants from government & academic elements.

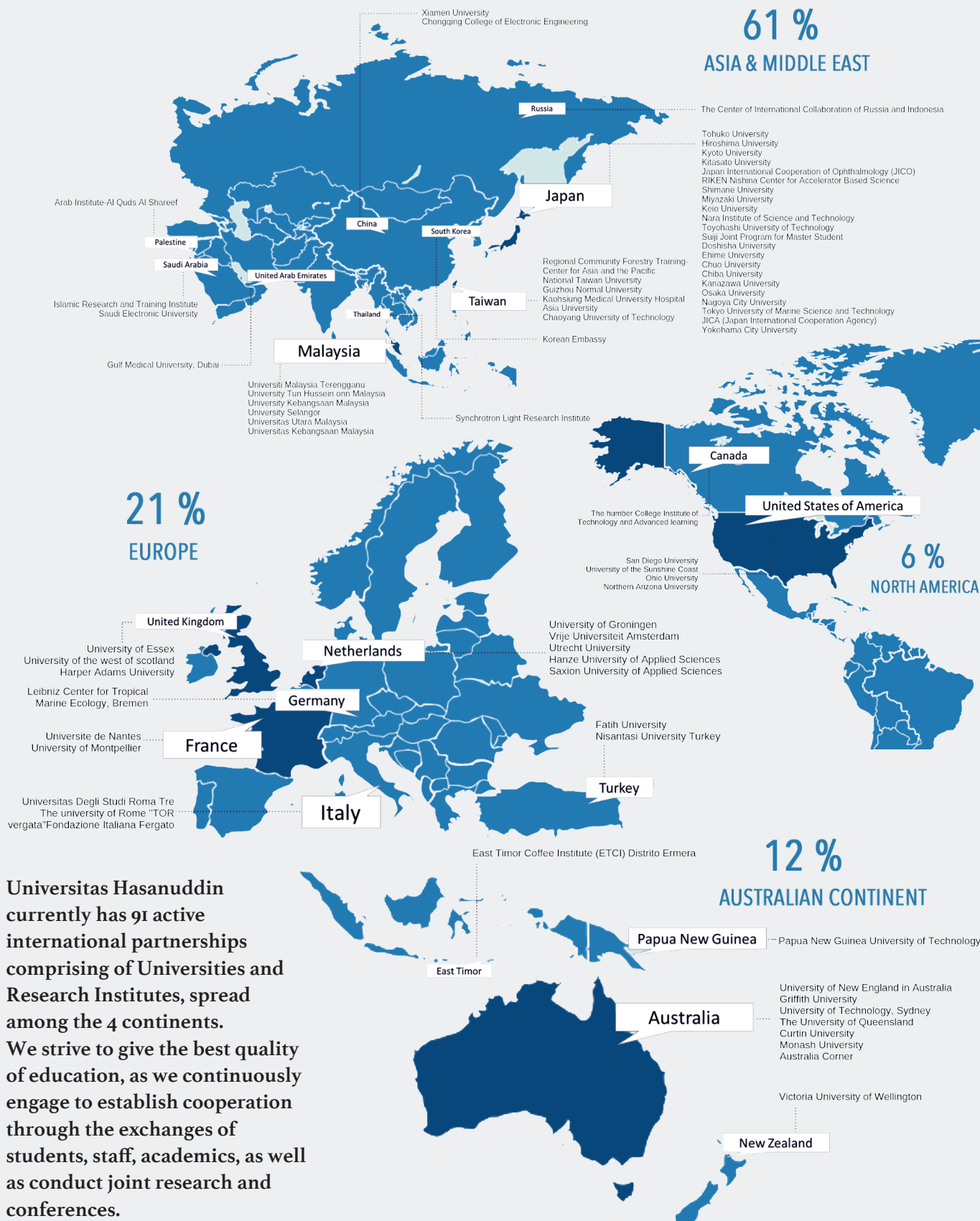

The Yokohama City University students also had a sharing session with the Faculty of Nursing lecturer, Moh, Syafar Sangkala, MANP who shared the experience during the disaster management in Palu and Lombok earthquake.

On the next day, August 28, 2019, the Yokohama City University Students together with the Faculty of Nursing students and Physiotherapy students conducted a sharing health education program about handwashing techniques for kindergarten children.
